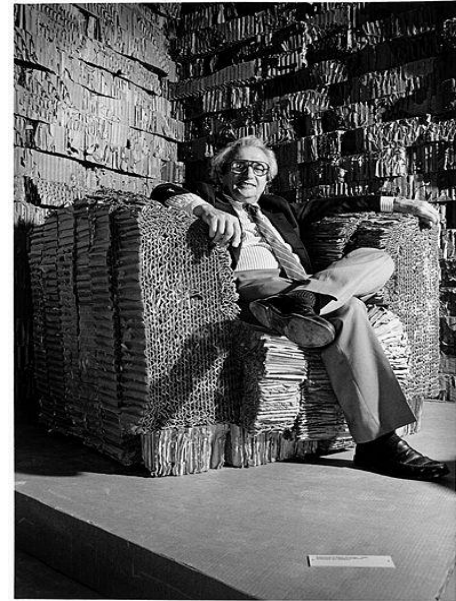


Frank Gehry 1929 - Present

His best known works included the titanium covered Walt Disney concert hall in downtown Los Angeles. 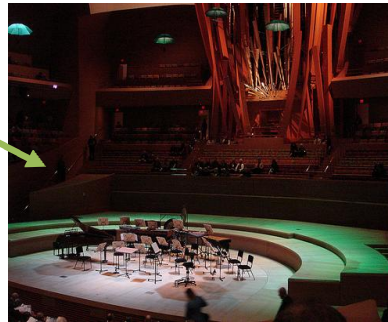
